GALLERIES

{ The Jaques Gallery }

An exciting addition to the center opened in 2004 – a new museum gallery space dedicated to the continuous exhibition of the work of Francis Lee Jaques and Florence Page Jaques. The JAC's collection includes original works of art and printed materials including calendars, note cards, postcards, nature-themed books, and books authored by Florence Page Jaques.

{ The Carnegie Gallery }

Housed in the historically preserved 1911 Carnegie Library building, the center hosts up to nine exhibits annually in its Carnegie Gallery. The exhibits range from selected artisans to inspirational and multi-cultural group exhibits.

The Jaques Art Center is committed to enriching and facilitating a creative spirit in the Aitkin area and the surround region.

EDUCATION

The Jaques Art Center seeks to inspire interest in the arts to educate and to generate opportunities for discovery at every age. Through workshops, lectures and demonstrations, the JAC allows artists to pass on their skills to adults and children. Weaving and creative workshops are available to art enthusiasts of all ages throughout the year.

GALLERY GIFTS

Housed on the main floor is the Gallery Gifts shop that presents the work of 85 local and regional consigned artists. Visitors to the center can purchase unique handcrafted gifts. Gallery Gifts also offers prints, artifacts and published works of Francis Lee Jaques and Florence Page Jaques.
